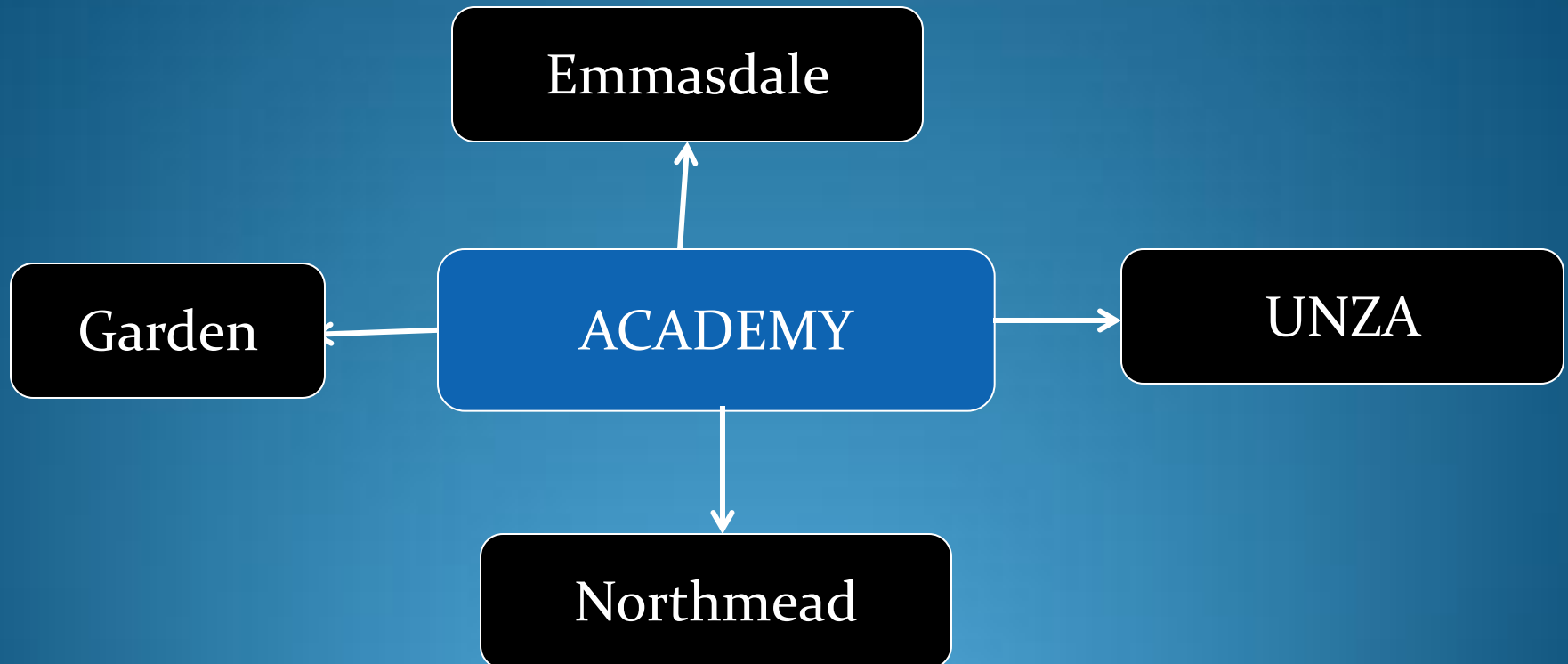
The Power of Sport and Play

4. On the global level, sport and physical education can have a long-lasting positive impact on development, public health, peace and the environment.



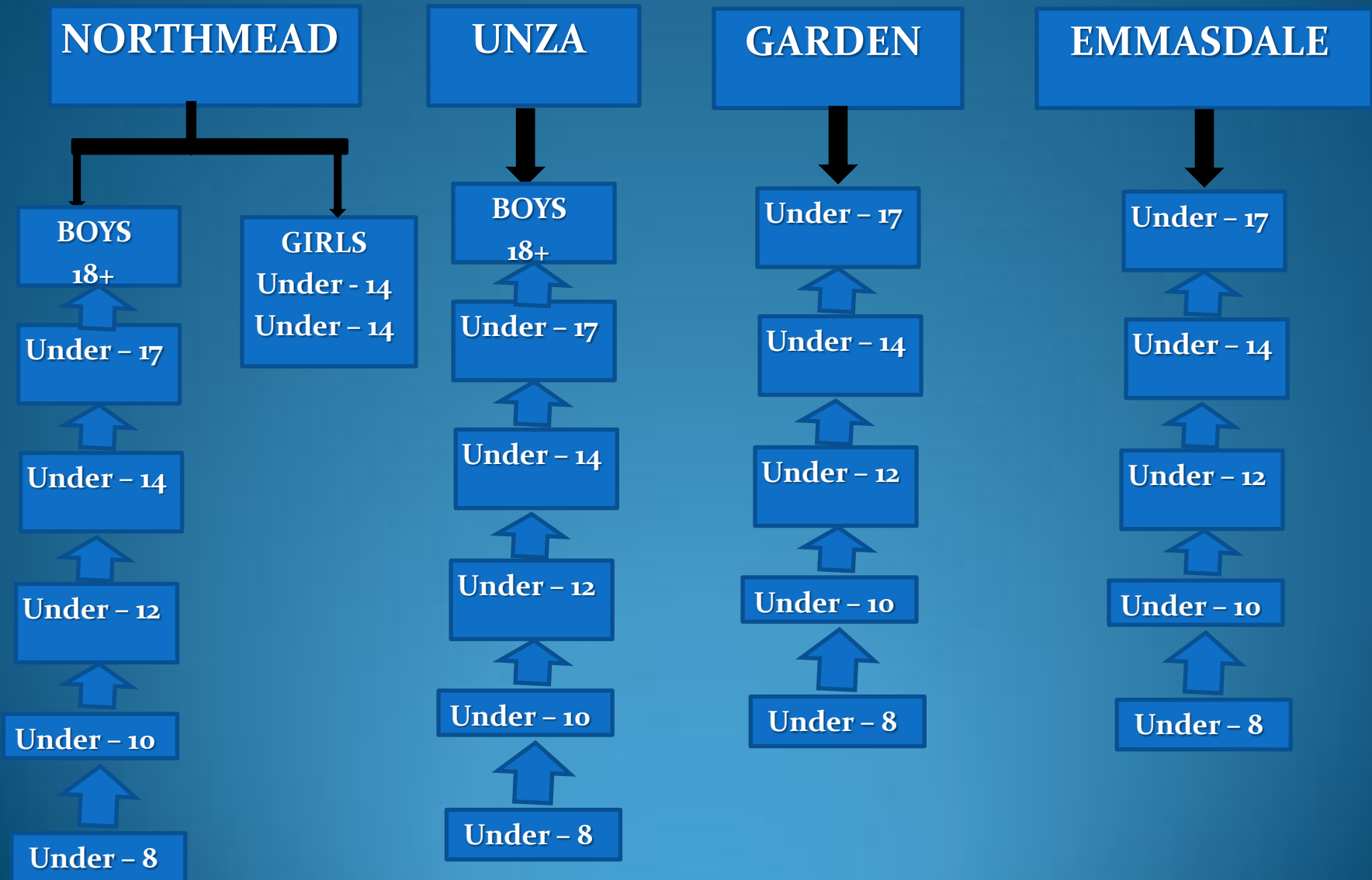


Structure of the Academy

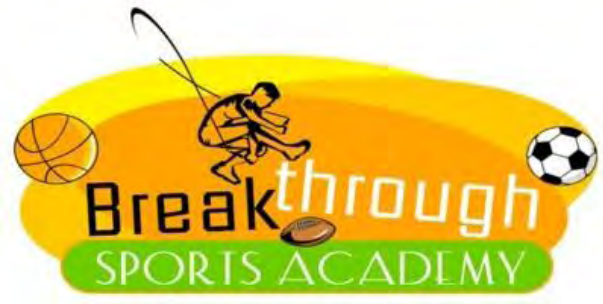

BACKGROUND

The project is based on the concept of the Mathare Youth Sports Association (MYSA) of Kenya. MYSA is the biggest youth sport initiative in Africa

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Community clean ups cleaning drainages and garbage sites

Garbage collection from unauthorized dumping grounds to designated bins

Unblocking and digging of trenches for running of water in the rainy season

Clear drainages with stagnant water to reduce flies and mosquito infestation

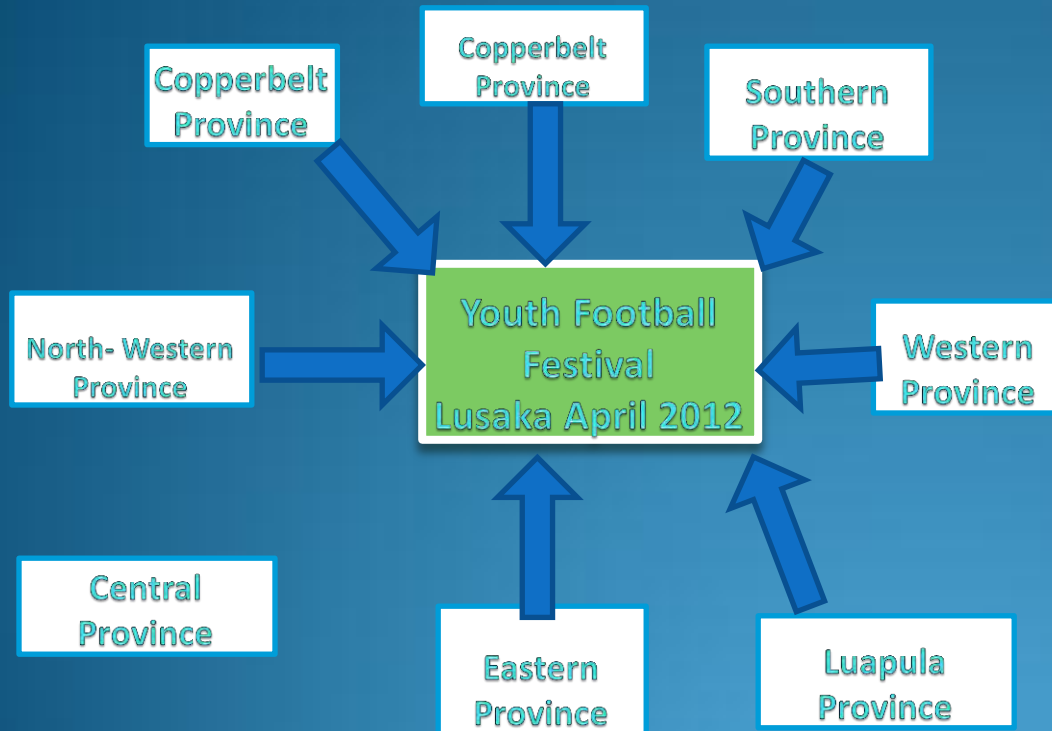
